7.1 Alignment of NMEG BRSs and NBM BRSs/IGs

7.1.1 BRS for Nordic trading system

8 Support to NBS (eSett)

Background: NMEG has made a set of BRSs for NBS (Nordic Balance Settlement). NMEG has also drafted a set of documents, both based on older ENTSO-E and eBIX® standards, and newer based on CIM. These BRSs and messages needs to be maintained and extended based on new requirements from the market.

Further, eSett is working on the migration of all exchanges to CIM based documents, however there’s a lot to take in and it’s not urgent from eSett perspective, the migration is expected to be something like:

- 1) eSett and TSOs (eSett’s SLA group) evaluate together when could be the suitable time to start the implementation in eSett. E.g. is it better timing to start e.g. in 2026. This is heavily dependent on other upcoming market changes.
- 2) eSett start to migrate the new CIM documents.
- 3) Once the new CIM documents have been implemented successfully in eSett, there is a minimum of 2-year transition period where we support both current non-CIM and the CIM documents in parallel to give market participants sufficient time to adapt to the change.
- 4) NMEG will follow up the migration process and if needed make new Maintenance Requests (MRs) to ENTSO-E.

Add a new ProcessType code for “NSL Intraday Auction (NSL IDA)” applicable in following Schedule contexts:

- Day-ahead/Intraday trade
- Day-ahead/Intraday flow

Purpose: enable separate reporting and settlement of NSL IDA positions from the current NSL day-ahead setup (current day-ahead setup: Process Type Z15 External trade).

Let me know if you have further questions.

9.5 New version of PRODAT to be used in Sweden from April 2026

From Jan (SE) December 19th:

A small update will be done in the usage of PRODAT next year in Sweden. It is related to the EU implementing regulation regarding access to metered data (EU 2023/1162).

The minor update is to add the "Installation" as an (optional) information sent to the ESCO in the message back where he gets the permission(s). I.e. not just sending the identification of the accounting point, but also the address to the installation that he gets permission for. It is optional since it will not be sent in "negative responses" where no permission is given.

It is no hurry to publish the document at <https://ediel.org/guides/>. It will replace the existing version v4r0A. It can be published after our next NMEG meeting, January 7th. I changed the version to v4r1A since it is an addition of an attribute in a type of PRODAT.

The yellow colour at page 1 and the date there would need to be changed before publication.

Update: homework for Ove to do the editorial and then publish it.

11 Report from JWG, with a special focus on datahub topics (fixed item on the agenda)

Background: The Joint Working Group (JWG) is formed from experts being nominated by the DSO Entity and ENTSO-E. In addition to those experts, three different Task Forces (TFs) with nominated representatives from both organisations have been created with the aim of supporting the goals of the JWG. The main tasks of these TFs are:

TF1: *“Monitoring Implementing Regulations (MIR)”*

- Develop guidance to assist Member States in reporting national practices concerning access to metering data.
- Collect and monitor national practices on the implementation of the reference models for this access.

TF2: *“Developing Implementing Regulations (DIR)”*

- Contributing to developing future implementing acts: customer switching [change of supplier] and demand response.

TF3: *“Data Interoperability Modelling (DIM)”*

- Keep a repository (roles, use cases and information objects) and ensure consistency of the reference models in the Implementing Acts.
- Map the reference model to standard models and, when necessary, propose amendments, extensions, and profiles for these standard models.
- Interact and collaborate with standardization organizations.

discuss or inform: Status in the TFs.

Report from TF3 (TF DIM) meeting updates 13/11:

- TF3 started drafting **HEMRM v2026**, reviewing IR DR roles and creating a new use-case package; role associations will be updated in the next meeting.
- The group agreed to include the **Grid Connection Point** domain, with links to metering and accounting points.
- TF3 reviewed SEEG Role SG proposals, clarifying balance per settlement period, BRP responsibility for balancing, trading as an Energy Trader task, and no functional difference between Energy Supplier and Eligible Party Energy Receiver.
- Work on the **Customer Switching IG** is progressing; completion planned for **Q1 2026**; IR CS expected to be **EIF Feb 2026**.
- All TF3 nominations (5 TSOs, 3 DSOs) were accepted, with welcome and intro meeting planned.
- The 2026 work plan includes IG IA CS, IG IA DR, CIM/ESMP mapping for AP characteristics, and HEMRM v2026.
- The **Permission class** will remain an European extension based on the TC 57 Joint meeting feedback.
- TF reviewed **IR DR Part 2**, gave feedback on information exchanges, and proposed needed attributes for Info Items.
- Work on the **IG DR** will start after the CS IG is completed, around **Q2 2026**.
- TF discussed the 2026 meeting plan.
- Enedis and EDF shared comparison material on measurement data documents and CIM profiles; **ESMP model v5** is updated and published on EDIlibrary with all the latest updates for 2025.
- JP and EL requested a guide on the alignment in the measurement data market document; TF3 SG will draft it.
- The IG for measurement data market document will be reviewed in **Q1 2026**, and TF members will present it at the **CEN/CENELEC meeting** once approved.

12 NMEG Technical Committee (NTC)

Background: At the NMEG meeting November 2019, it was agreed to establish a NMEG CIM-XML Subgroup that will make Nordic CIM based XML documents. The following tasks are prioritised (updated at NMEG meeting February 2025):

- a) Review of needed MRs in Appendix A and (at least) submit MRs that are needed for more than one country.
- b) Finalise BRS for change of supplier, i.e. addition of new document for “End of supply”
- c) Start on new BRS for exchange of Accounting Point characteristics
- d) Continue CIM model of the grid part of the Elhub Information Model (EIM)

The members of NMEG CIM-XML Subgroup are Bent Atle, Christian, Jan (DK), Jan (SE), Jon-Egil, Mario, Rasmus, Svein, Teemu H, Teemu K and Ove.

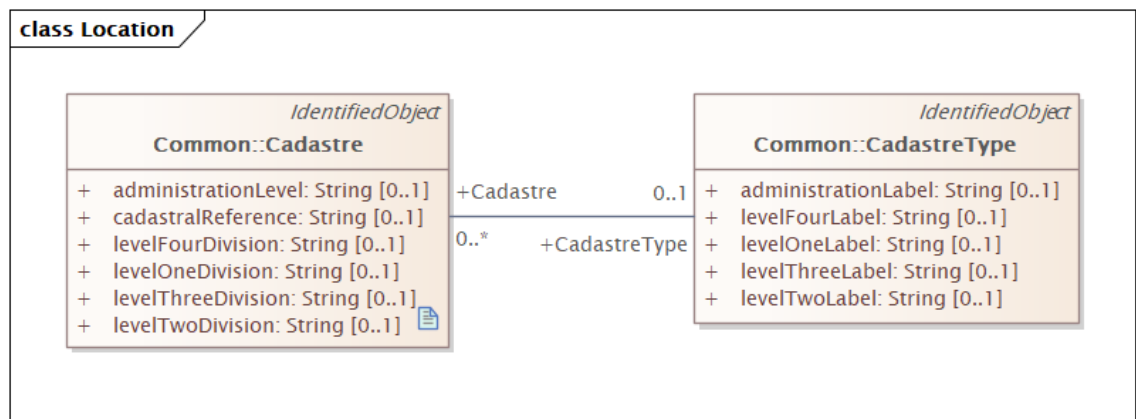
The item was postponed until next NTC.

12.1.2 [Cadastre](#)

From Svein:

Cadastre has been a nightmare. We have spent about 10 hours discussing this. Cadastre is different in all the Nordic countries, it can be different inside a US state as well.

That is why we included CadastreType that can configure the Cadastre:



the class and attributes description should be very clear. But 61968-11 should have a part that explain this.

Conclusion:

- Used in Norway with four fields, hence we need the Cadastre Class in our AP Characteristics document.
- Used in Denmark as one string, i.e. sent in `UsagePointLocation.GeoInfoReference`.
- To be used in Sweden, probably similar as in Denmark.
- Not used in Finland in the foreseeable future.

12.1.3 [CIM18-Review-Agent-and-Address](#)

We received the document “CIM18-Review-Agent-and-Address” from Svein on Sunday December 7th :

Some comments/questions:

- Should we rename the associations in our Request change of supplier model according to “Person Name Components”, such as rename `middleName` to `additionalName`?

Conclusion:

- Awaiting results from TF14 discussions by the end of the week
- How do we handle “Care Of Address” and “On Behalf Of Address”? Could we handle these as associations to the Name class instead?

From Svein:

- The `coAddress` attribute is part of the Address and represents the routing instruction (for example “c/o Accounting Services AS”, “vaktmester – Solvang skole”). It should be populated based on the organisational or agent relationships (for example which party handles mail or

operational correspondence on behalf of the organisation), but remains stored with the Address so that the complete postal label can be constructed from the structured fields.

- I would not recommend to use Name class. Name in CIM is for alternative names or labels: local names, code names, system names.

Care-of and on-behalf-of are not just names; they are postal routing / delegation semantics:

- “Send it via X”
- “Contact Y who handles this”

Conclusion:

- Svein will investigate and come back with a proposal for how to add Care Of and On Behalf Of names
- How to link a Person or Organisation to a PhysicalAddress?

Conclusion:

- We link the AP to the PhysicalAddress and the Customer to the PostalAddress
- Svein will propose to move the municipality attribute from PhysicalAddress to Address
- Søren had asked if we need several nationalities.

Conclusion:

- Seems not to be needed in any of the NMEG documents.
- Søren had also commented the OrganisationCategoryKind enumeration.

Conclusion:

- Seems not to be needed for our (NMEGS) documents, however Svein will investigate with the DSOs in TF16 if they see a need.
- Svein explained the usage if URIs

Due to lack of time the following questions/comments were postponed until next meeting:

- Contacting a customer, why “two steps”?
- Some more issues (from Jan (SE) to be (further) discussed...
 - Is a Customer an “AgentRole”?
 - How do we link (assign) a Person to an Organisation?

 - Why can’t a Customer (directly) have ContactPoints?
 - Why can’t a UsagePointLocation (directly) have an address?
 - How do we specify addresses for a CustomerContract?
 - PostalAddress is both a datatype and a class, however associated in an odd way, to be checked how PostalAddress will be handled in profiles

We can, maybe, have a chat about it in next NTC? Maybe this is not as hard as Grid Model mapping. I can give an introduction and reasoning in the meeting.

The first half of the meeting was used to try mapping the first class-diagram in [Appendix B to CIM](#), however without coming very far. Among others because of missing understanding of the content of the Elhub' classes and attributes. Hence it was decided to invite Elisabet Lofthus from Elhub to our next meeting to explain the content of the Elhub' classes and attributes.

For information; “NMEG/2025 235 - Add extendedStorage (Boolean) to the MarketEvaluationPoint in CIM/Market and ESMP” was rejected – seen as a Norwegian speciality.

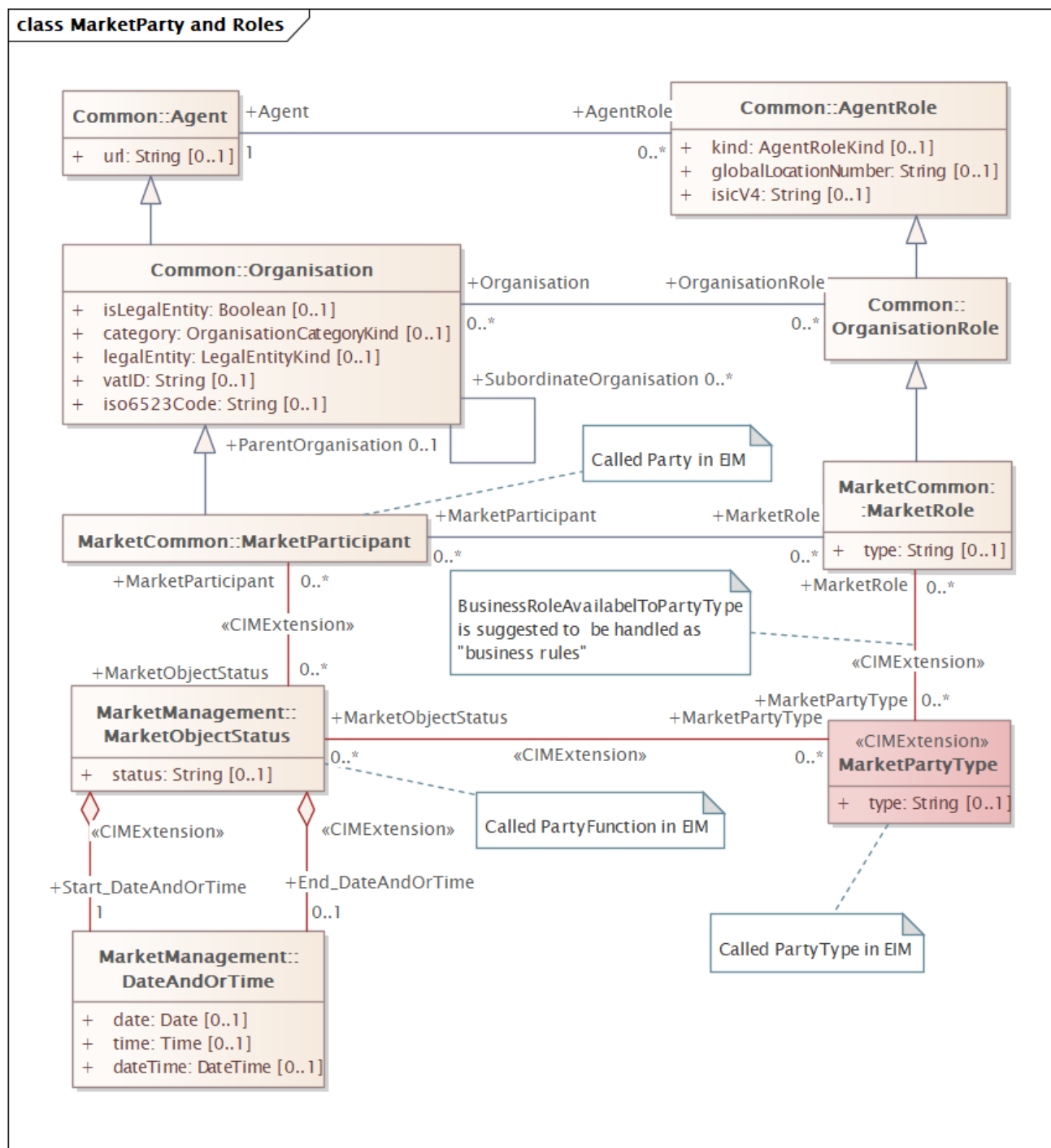

12.3 [Report from NTC meeting Tuesday December 17th, 2025](#)

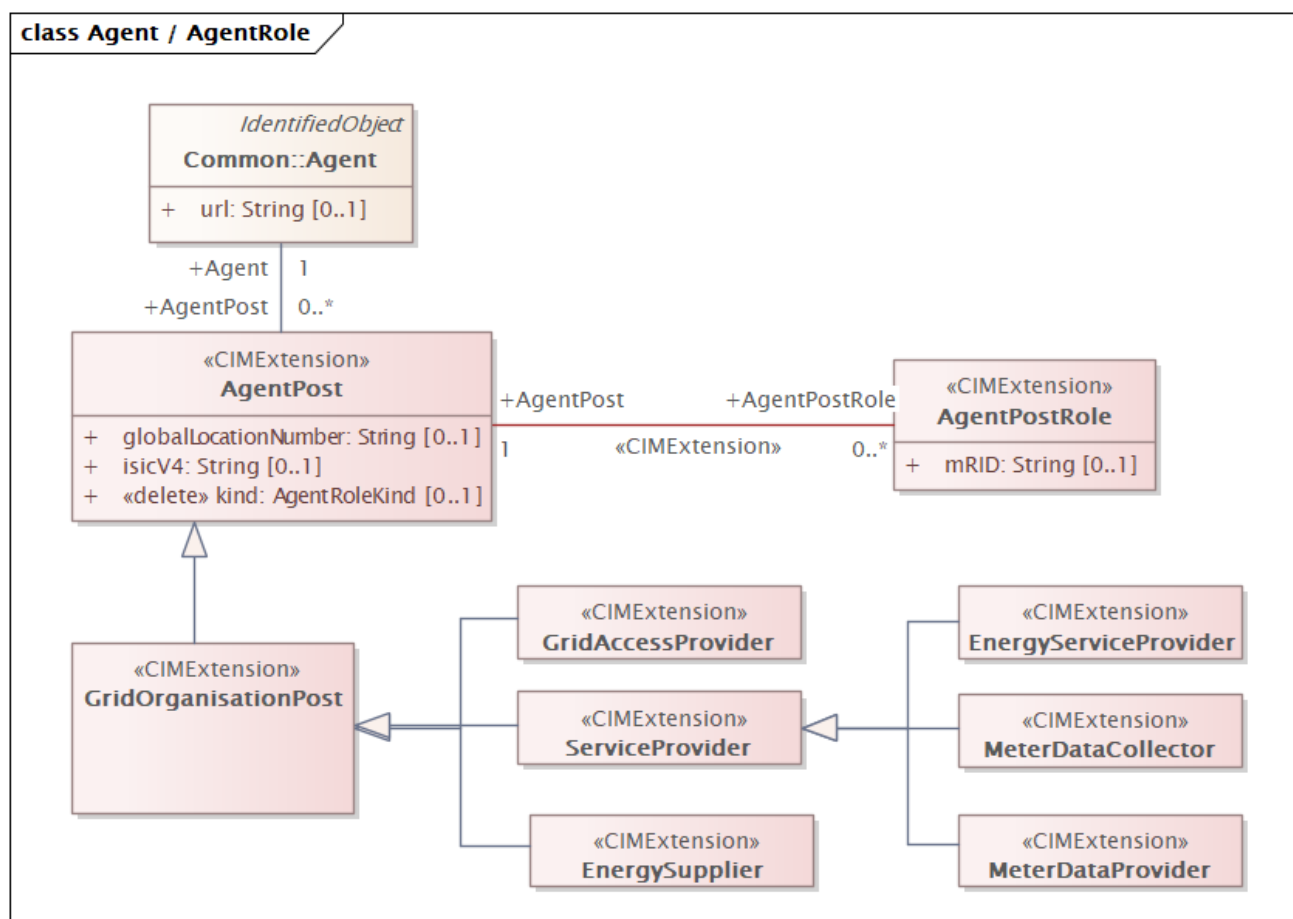
Present: Elisabeth (Elhub), Jan (SE), Jan (DK), Mario, Ove, Svein (last ½ hour) and Teemu K.
